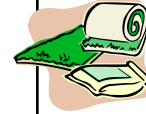

ABSOLUTELY NO PAINT WILL BE ACCEPTED

To dispose of paint:

- In a well-ventilated area; air dry paint away from children and pets.
- Add absorbent material such as shredded newspaper or kitty litter and **allow to dry completely**. Some home improvement stores may sell an inexpensive paint hardener (*Check your local stores*).
- If paint has already hardened in can, take off the lid and throw the dried paint away with your regular trash.
- Donate useable leftover paint to local community groups, theater groups, schools, churches and others who need or want it. Your local Habitat for Humanity ReStore also accepts useable paint. You may even be able to take a tax deduction.
- Organize a neighborhood paint exchange.
