Health Commissioner:

COVID-19 Update- Sadly, we do have to report our first COVID-19 related death. County case numbers will be increasing significantly due to mass testing at the 2 prison facilities in our county. Staff positives will be reported to the county of residence while the inmate positives will be counted as our county cases. We could potentially see daily cases in the 100's. The total case count should include a breakdown of the inmate count. Traci added that we do not have any jurisdictional authority in the prisons.

Traci is calling in to 3 weekly radio interviews; Paul James, Jeff Ruth and Scott Spears. We are hoping to develop more detailed case demographics report. There is still a State-wide shortage of testing availability.

We will expect guidance on how the State plans to phase in the slow opening of businesses after current order expires May 1st.
